

5th Macro Regional Advisory Panel – Mediterranean Region

Overview

The **5th PREMIERE Macro-Regional Advisory Panel (MRAP) for the Mediterranean region** will bring together panel members to share experiences, best practices, and lessons learned, and to explore ways to strengthen multi-actor proposals under Horizon Europe. The session will review the regional MAA landscape, highlight practical experiences from proposal preparation and implementation, and introduce new **PREMIERE tools and services** designed to support future applications.

Participants will also discuss **trends in MAA**, reflect on lessons from the 2025 call preparations, and look ahead to opportunities and challenges for the **2026–2027 Work Programme**. The meeting will provide an opportunity to deepen collaboration, foster cross-learning, and enhance networking within the Mediterranean panel and across other macro-regions.
